My role involves working in collaboration with professionals to outline and evidence specific support requirements and to devise person-centred rehabilitation plans for my clients. The aim is to enable an individual to reach their rehabilitation potential and get their quality of life as far as possible to how it was pre-injury.

This involves working closely with clients, their parents and families and partners in police, probation and social services, solicitors and deputies. My role requires me to implement goal-focused rehabilitation programmes that reflect client's interests, motivations and aspirations.

I have experience in setting up care packages including recruiting and managing care teams to ensure care plan actions are followed. As an occupational therapist I have gained experience in issuing assistive technology, specialist equipment and working with Architects on major building projects that allow clients to leave rehabilitation environments and live in their own homes.

I have also developed a sound working knowledge of practice relating to consent and capacity and experience in working within the parameters of the Mental Capacity Act, including leading Best Interests Meetings.

I strive to base my approach on the principles of client-centred practice, and I feel that one of my main strengths is my ability to develop therapeutic relationships with my clients, based on empathy, trust and respect.

I am experienced in preparing witness statements, supporting clients to Medico-Legal appointments, attending meetings with Counsel and joint settlement meetings.
