Stacey moved into the community setting as a SCPHN working as a School Health Nurse on secondment and worked in a cluster of state and private high schools promoting the health and public health needs of the adolescents. She was part of the multi-disciplinary team in South Manchester to pilot and deliver the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine to adolescent girls in 2008.

In 2009 Stacey joined Greater Manchester Police (GMP) as a Safeguarding Case Management Lead covering all geographical districts in Manchester. Working directly with all partnership agencies relating to child protection, sexual exploitation, domestic abuse and organised crime, attending case conferences relating those matters. She led a small team and provided day to day management relating to the provision of child safeguarding operation planning. This included recruiting staff for her team and regularly mentoring them during their induction period.

Daily she assessed complex risks and intelligence and made recommendations to achieve positive outcomes. For over a decade she worked in the community setting with vulnerable families daily. Throughout her career she has been involved in very high-profile cases, auditing projects relating to Honour Based Violence and supported and worked with females that made disclosures and allegations relating to abuse suffered at the hands of Jimmy Saville.

Stacey always had a passion for justice, and this led to her privately studying at the University of Law and successfully completing her legal qualifications to enable her to practice law.
